This year we are also pleased to announce that we will be offering hoodies and tumblers with the WFW 2022 logo as a fundraiser to support Foundation Outreach International (FOI).

FOI sponsors many projects, including English-language skills classes, teen camps in Africa, and the Hilltop Outreach Program. The most significant portion of FOI's budget is a scholarship program currently supporting about 60 students in Africa, helping them gain the essential skills they need. In Africa high school is not provided and parents must find the funds to support their child's education. The average amount per child is \$350-\$500 annually.

All proceeds from the hoodie and tumbler sales will go directly to FOI to support their mission to do a world of good around the world.
