MEAL TICKETS:

This year **meal tickets** will be given to the head of household along with a Super Social bulletin.

- If you have made hotel room reservations, you will be given complimentary hotel breakfast passes for the number of individuals in your reservation.
- For those that have paid for the meals provided throughout the Super Social weekend, color coded meal tickets will be provided.

- Please remember to bring appropriate meal ticket to each meal, as they will be requested in order to eat.

FRIDAY NIGHT BUFFET

We begin seating for our dinner at 6:15pm. This is located in the main ballroom. The blessing will be asked at 6:30pm and the serving line will open. Tables will be given indication when to go through the line. The buffet line will be open until 8:00pm. The menu includes: Chicken Piccata, Roast Prime Rib with Beef Au Jus, Garlic Whipped Potatoes, Honey Glazed Baby Carrots, Green Beans Almandines, bread and beverages.
